Other members may advise me on safe work practices, but this does not constitute a training, or a supervisory relationship and responsibility for safety using *Vancouver Hack Space Society* facilities lies entirely on myself.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: The participant fully assumes all risks associated with participation in events and exempts and releases *Vancouver Hack Space Society*, its members, officers, agents, and board members, from action whatsoever arising out of any damage, loss or injury to the participant or the participant's property while upon the premises or using any equipment of the organization or while participating in any of the activities contemplated by this agreement whether such loss, damage, or injury results from the negligence of the corporation, its members, agents, or from some other cause.

COVENANT NOT TO SUE: The participant agrees never to institute any suit or action at law otherwise against *Vancouver Hack Space Society*, its members, officers, board members, agents, nor to initiate or any way assist the prosecution of any claim for damages or course of action which the member, member's heirs, executors or administrators hereafter may have by reason of injury to the person of the member or to the participant's property arising from the activities contemplated by this agreement.
